Happy New Year to all our Wheels for Kids volunteers, supporters and donors! Wheels for Kids is an organization consisting of 100% volunteers!

Thanks to you, we have been able to significantly increase our distributions of bikes to our supported charities. This year we donated **243** to charities and another **49** to BICAS, a charity which uses bikes not feasible for us to repair. Since our founding in 2007, we have donated a total of **1,312** bikes to those in need in the Tucson area.

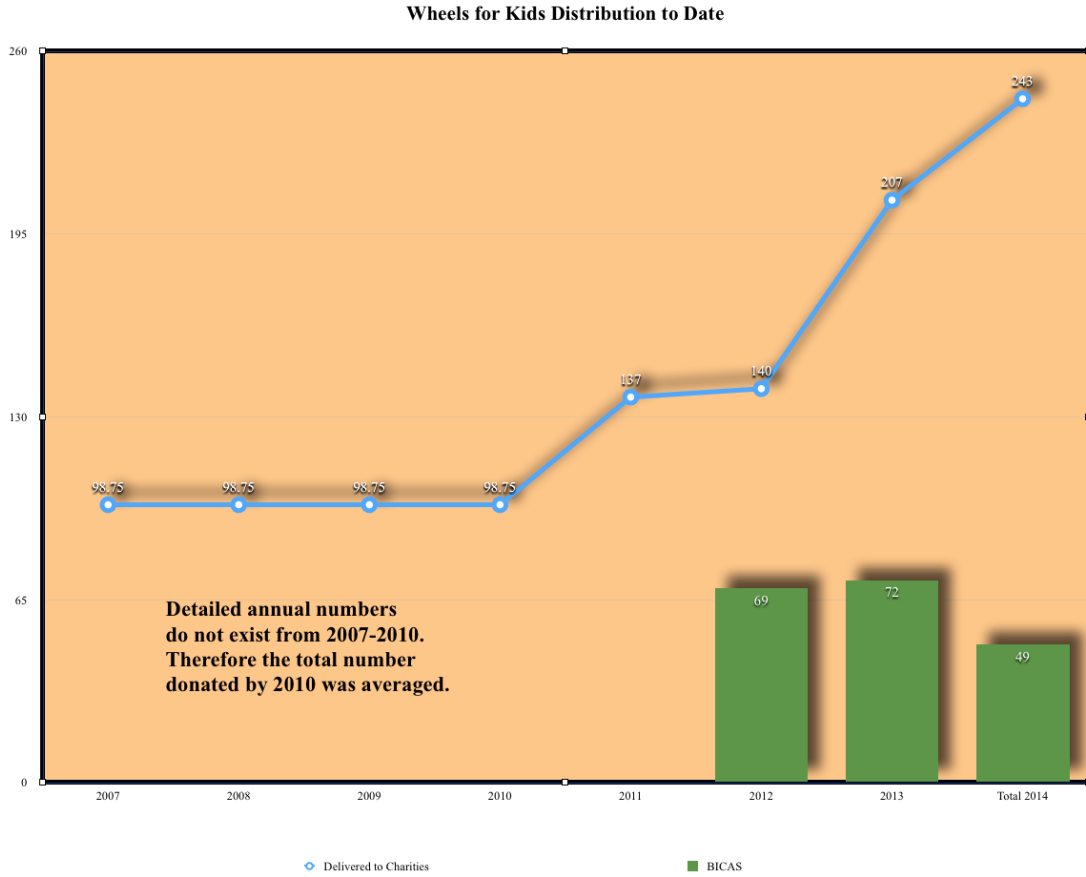
Our network of supported charities continues to grow, providing a steady outlet for our product — bikes of all types and sizes.

Supported charities now include: ***Boys and Girls Club, El Grupo Youth Cycling, GAP Ministeries, Gospel Rescue Mission, Interfaith Community Services, Perimeter Bicycling, Pima County DOT, Pima County Middle School Program, Ronald MacDonald House Charities Southern Arizona (RMHC), SISTER Connection, Tu Nidito Children and Family Services, Tucson Unified School District-Educational Enrichment Foundation, U of A Health Programs, Kristy's Kids and Youth On Their Own (YOTO).***

We now have nine drop-off locations covering the Tucson area.

They are: ***Oro Valley Bicycle (3 locations), Trek Bicycle (2 locations), Fair Wheel Bikes, Perimeter Bicycling, TriSports and the Roy Drachman Clubhouse of the Boys and Girls Club.***

Your financial support continues to grow enabling us to purchase **41 new bikes** this year. It also enabled us to purchase a trailer that will facilitate hauling donated bikes from our drop off locations and also to make the deliveries of large quantities of bikes, rather than the few that we could get into a pickup truck or personal vehicle.
